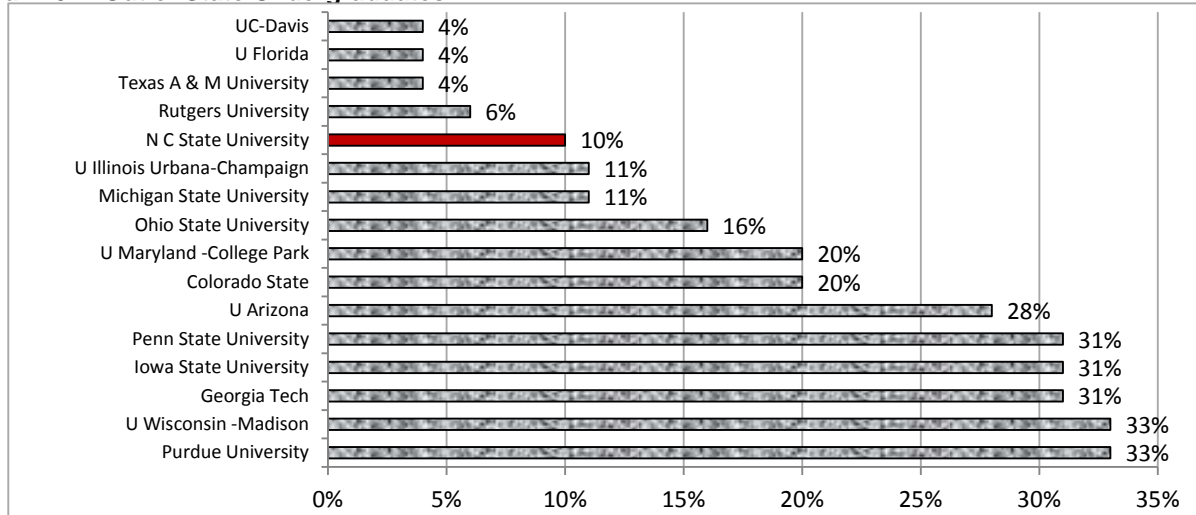

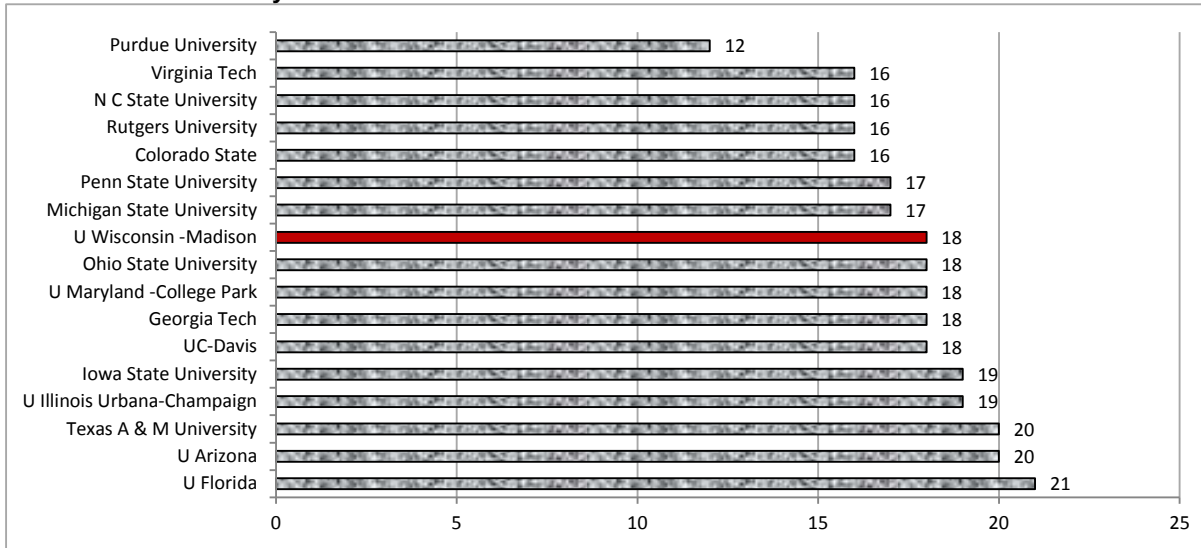
Fall 2014 Out of State Undergraduates

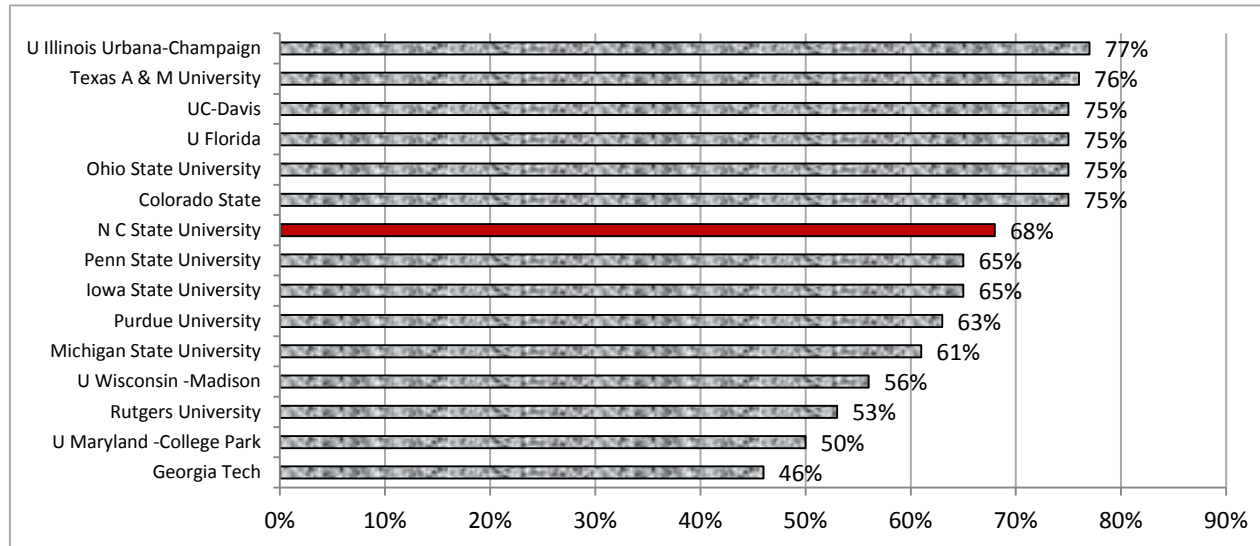

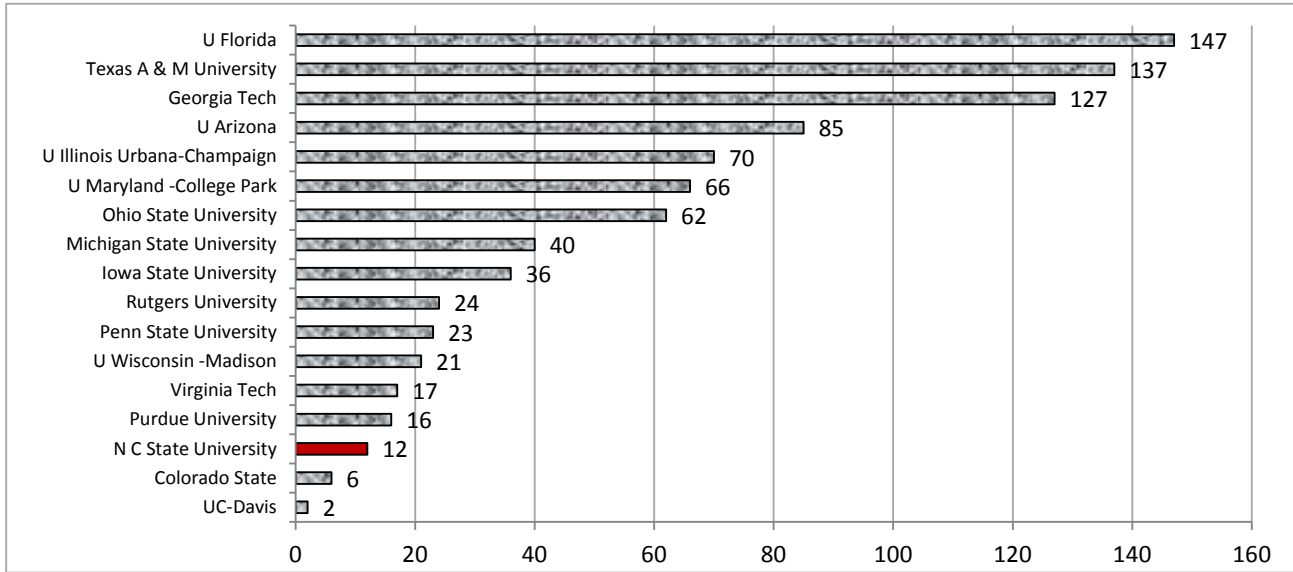

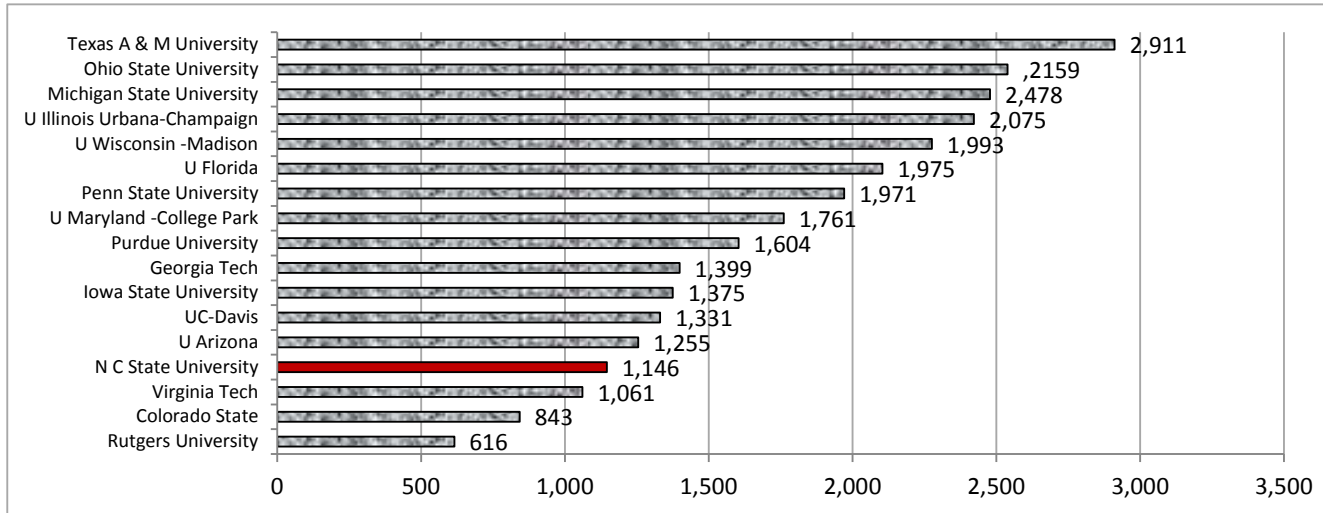

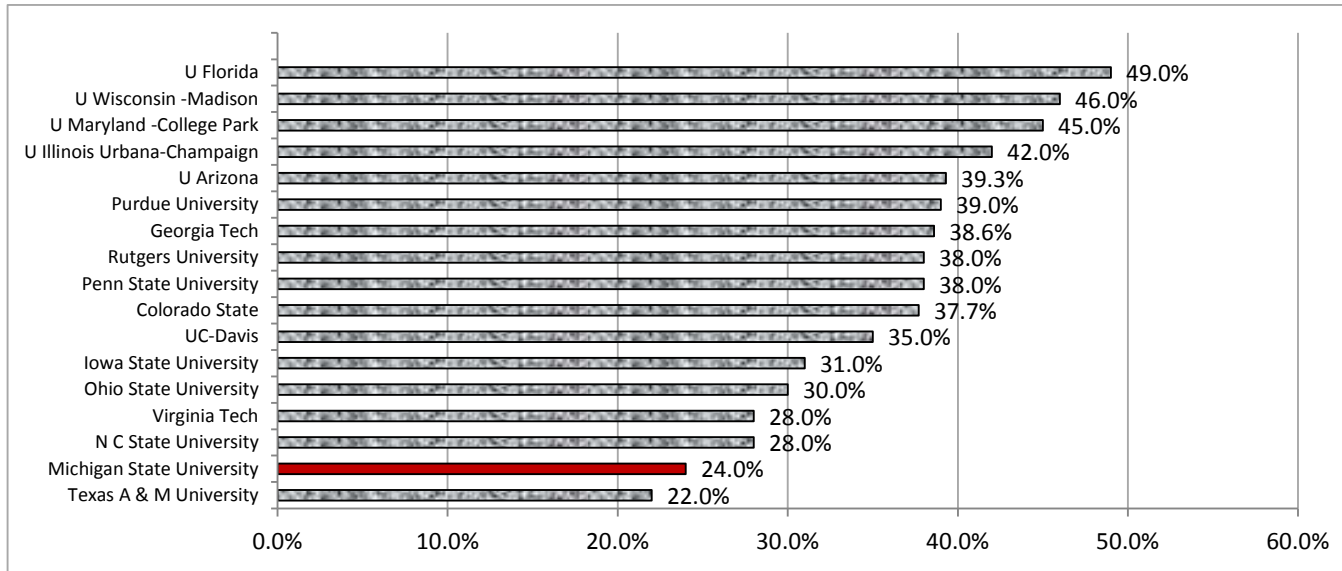
Students Participating in Study Abroad 2013-14

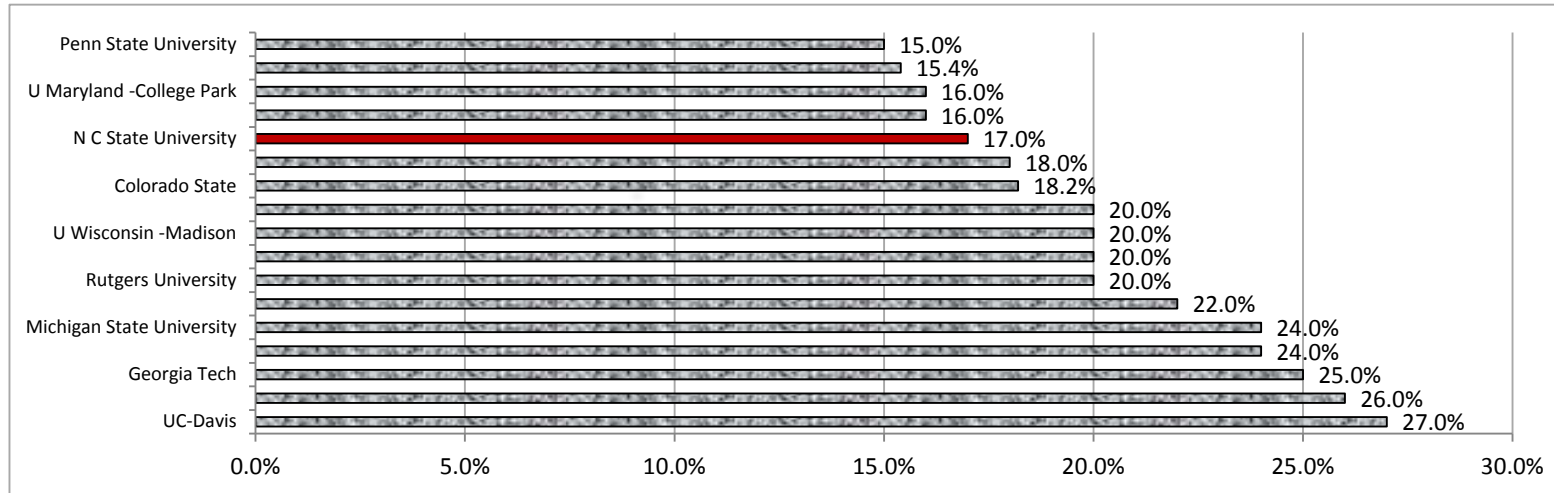
