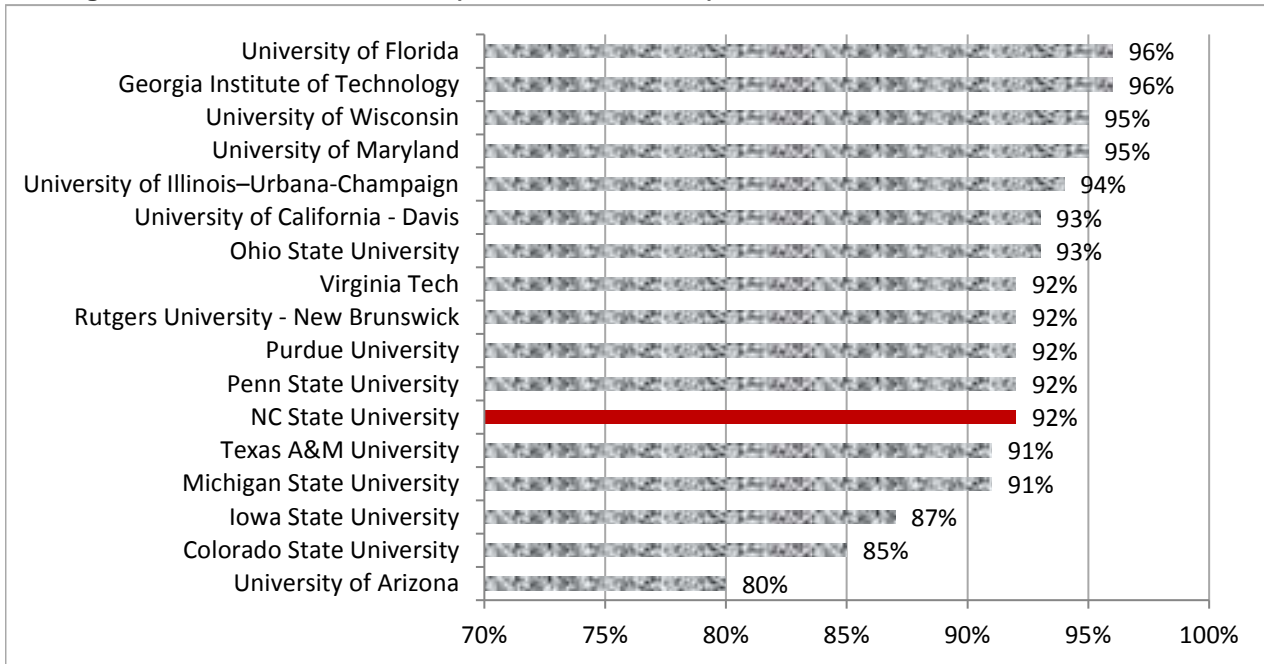

## Average Freshman Retention Rate (based on 2014 data)

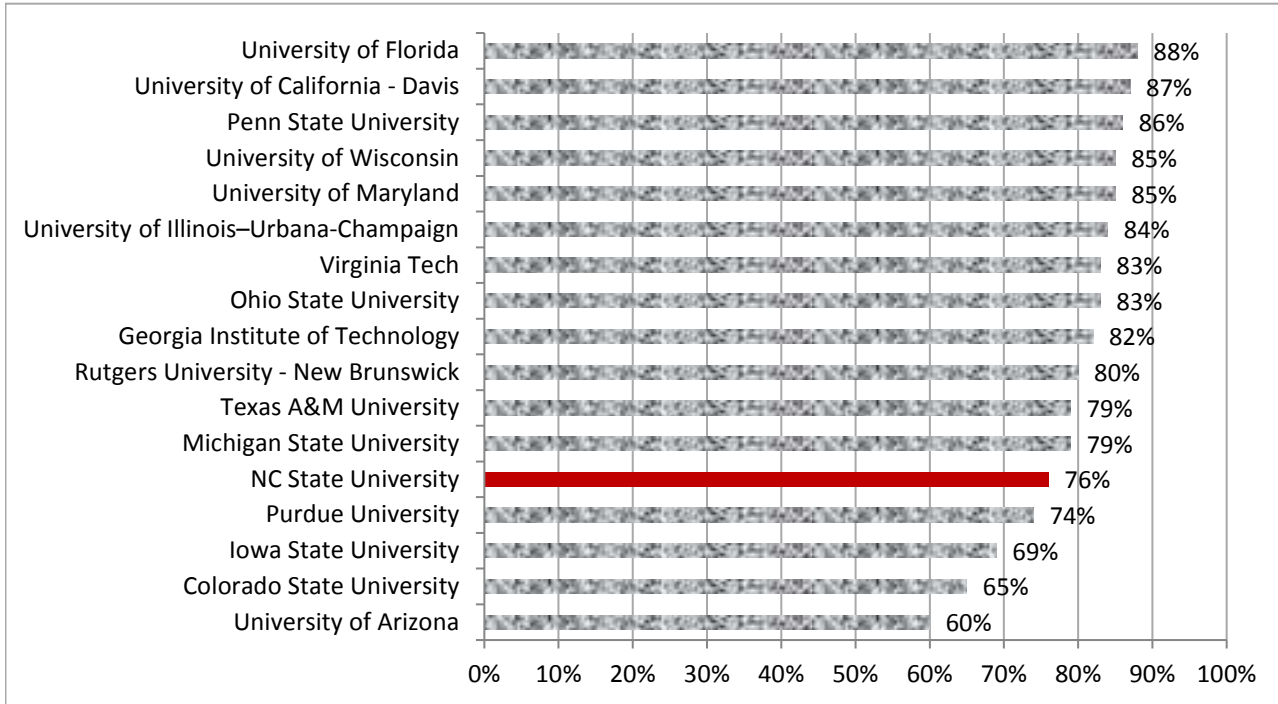


Average Freshman Retention Rate: average percentage of first-year students who entered the school in the fall of 2010 through the fall of 2013 and returned the following fall.
